Registration is possible using the Rabaska tool available through a student's uoZone account (www.uoZone.uOttawa.ca). Not all courses are offered every session; students must consult www.timetable.uOttawa.ca to verify in which session courses are offered. All prerequisites must be successfully completed before registration to a course. It is the students' responsibility to consult Rabaska regularly to confirm their registration.

Students who do not obtain the minimum grade in a compulsory course taken for the first time must repeat the course successfully; otherwise they must withdraw from the Telfer School of Management.
