- OPT: Twelve units from another faculty. Students must complete 6 of these units in a third language and/or related culture course. Note that not many of these options are offered during the summer term. At most six of these units can be at the 1000 level.
- ADM 3358 cannot be combined with ADM 4354 for credits.
- Four (4) ADM 4000 level courses required to graduate (including ADM 4311).
- ADM courses at the 4000 level are reserved for: 1) B.Com. Students who have completed at least 33 units from ADM core courses, including ADM 2381/2781.

Full-time status must be maintained during study terms.

If you have not followed this course sequence, you may not be able to finish within the suggested timeframe.
