NGO Subsidies Project

The Faculty of Social Sciences (FSS) and the CO-OP Programs have an NGO subsidies project to offer wage subsidies to local non-profit organizations for the summer work term.



Here are the objectives and criteria of the wage subsidy project:

- A subsidy of \$7 an hour for 35 hours per week for 16 weeks is being offered. This translates into \$3,920 per student per work term.
- The NGO contributes \$3,920 towards the salary, for a total salary of \$7,840 per 16-week work term (i.e., student earns \$14 an hour).
- Subsidies are available **only for master's students** in:
 - Anthropology (MA)
 - Economics (MA)
 - Globalization and International Development (MA)
 - Public Administration (MA)
 - Public and International Affairs (MA)
 - Sociology (MA)
- NGOs agree to promote the CO-OP program in their network to help us find other work terms for uOttawa CO-OP students.
- NGOs can consider working with an FSS professor and master's student on a research project.
- Organizations will be invited to make presentations at uOttawa on a subject relevant to the program of study.
